- (b) An individual who holds an elected or appointed local 16 government office may be appointed to the governing body of a state 17 agency if otherwise eligible. The individual may not receive 18 compensation for serving on the governing body of the state agency 19 but may be reimbursed as provided by other law for a reasonable and 20 21 necessary expense incurred in the performance of an official 22 function.
- (c) Rules adopted under Section 574.003 are not required to 23 24 implement this section.
