## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-8 relating to certification in first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation for certain school district employees. 1-9 1-10 1-11

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 33.086, Education Code, 1-12 is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (a) A school district employee who serves as the head director of a school marching band or as the head coach or chief 1-14 sponsor for an extracurricular athletic activity, including cheerleading, sponsored or sanctioned by a school district or the University Interscholastic League must maintain and submit to the 1**-**15 1**-**16 1-17 1-18 district proof of current certification in first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation issued by the American Red Cross, the American Heart Association, or another organization that provides equivalent training and certification. 1-19 1-20 1-21

1-22 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004 1-23 school year.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-25 1-26 1-27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-28 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
