1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to certification in first aid and cardiopulmonary  
1-9 resuscitation for certain school district employees.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 33.086, Education Code,  
1-12 is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (a) A school district employee who serves as the head  
1-14 director of a school marching band or as the head coach or chief  
1-15 sponsor for an extracurricular athletic activity, including  
1-16 cheerleading, sponsored or sanctioned by a school district or the  
1-17 University Interscholastic League must maintain and submit to the  
1-18 district proof of current certification in first aid and  
1-19 cardiopulmonary resuscitation issued by the American Red Cross, the  
1-20 American Heart Association, or another organization that provides  
1-21 equivalent training and certification.

1-22 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004  
1-23 school year.

1-24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-28 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
