A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the study and implementation of water desalination.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS. The legislature finds
- 5 that:
- 6 (1) it is in the public interest to develop and
- 7 maintain a diversified portfolio of drought-proof water supply
- 8 alternatives to meet the water needs of this state;
- 9 (2) on-going advances in water treatment technology
- 10 and the growing demand on water resources make water desalination a
- 11 more attractive drought-proof water supply option for this state;
- 12 and
- 13 (3) additional information is necessary to further
- 14 assess the implementation of and future opportunities for seawater
- 15 desalination in this state.
- 16 SECTION 2. WATER DESALINATION: RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT,
- 17 REPORT, AND FUNDING. (a) The Texas Water Development Board shall
- 18 undertake and participate in research, feasibility, and facility
- 19 planning studies, investigations, and surveys, as it considers
- 20 necessary, to further the development of cost-effective water
- 21 supplies from desalination in this state.
- (b) Not later than January 1, 2004, the Texas Water
- 23 Development Board shall prepare and submit a progress report to the
- governor, the lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of

- 1 representatives on the implementation of water desalination
- 2 activities in the state. The report shall include:
- 3 (1) the results of the board's studies and activities
- 4 relating to water desalination during the preceding biennium;
- 5 (2) identification and evaluation of research,
- 6 regulatory, technical, and financial impediments to the
- 7 implementation of water desalination projects;
- 8 (3) evaluation of the role the state should play in
- 9 furthering the development of large-scale seawater desalination
- 10 projects in this state; and
- 11 (4) the anticipated appropriation from general
- 12 revenues necessary to continue investigating water desalination
- 13 activities in the state during the upcoming biennium.
- 14 (c) The Texas Water Development Board shall actively pursue
- 15 federal sources of funding for desalination projects in this state.
- SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September
- 17 1, 2003.
