3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
5	is amended by adding Section 502.2952 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 502.2952. TEXAS CONSTABLE LICENSE PLATES. (a) The
7	department shall design and provide for the issuance of special
8	license plates for a passenger car or light truck that is owned by a
9	person who is a constable or deputy constable of this state.
10	(b) License plates issued under this section shall bear the
11	words "Texas Constable."
12	(c) The department shall issue license plates under this
13	section to a person who:
14	(1) applies to the county tax collector in the county
15	of the person's residence on a form prescribed by the department;
16	(2) pays the fee prescribed by Subsection (d); and
17	(3) submits with the application proof that the person
18	is a constable or deputy constable of this state.
19	(d) The fee for registration under this section and issuance
20	of the special license plates is the fee otherwise prescribed by
21	this chapter for the vehicle.
22	(e) Registration under this section is valid for one year
23	and expires in the same manner as do regular motor vehicle
24	registrations, except as provided by Subsection (f).

1	(f) Registration under this section expires when the owner
2	of the vehicle for which the special plates were issued ceases to be
3	a constable or deputy constable. The owner shall return the special
4	license plates to the department.
5	(g) If the owner of a vehicle for which plates are issued
6	under this section disposes of the vehicle during a registration
7	year, the person shall return the special plates to the department
8	and at that time may apply for issuance of those plates to another
9	vehicle.
10	(h) If license plates issued under this section are lost,
11	stolen, or mutilated, the owner of the vehicle for which the plates
12	were issued may obtain replacement plates from the department by
13	paying a replacement fee of \$5.
14	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
