Section 12.42(c)(2), Penal Code, is amended to 6 read as follows: (2) A defendant shall be punished by imprisonment in 7 the institutional division for life if: 8 (A) the defendant is convicted of an offense: 9 (i) under Section <u>21.11, 22.011, or</u> 22.021 10 11 [or 22.011], Penal Code; 12 (ii) under Section 20.04(a)(4), Penal Code, 13 if the defendant committed the offense with the intent to violate or 14 abuse the victim sexually; or (iii) under Section 30.02, Penal Code, 15 punishable under Subsection (d) of that section, if the defendant 16 committed the offense with the intent to commit a felony described 17 by Subparagraph (i) or (ii) or a felony under Section 21.11 or 18 22.011, Penal Code; and 19 (B) the defendant has been previously convicted 20 21 of an offense: 22 (i) under Section 43.25 or 43.26, Penal 23 Code; (ii) under Section 21.11, 22.011, 22.021, 24

1 or 25.02, Penal Code; (iii) under Section 20.04(a)(4), 2 Penal 3 Code, if the defendant committed the offense with the intent to 4 violate or abuse the victim sexually; 5 (iv) under Section 30.02, Penal Code, 6 punishable under Subsection (d) of that section, if the defendant committed the offense with the intent to commit a felony described 7 8 by Subparagraph (ii) or (iii); or laws 9 (v) under the of another state containing elements that are substantially similar to the elements 10 of an offense listed in Subparagraph (i), (ii), (iii), or (iv). 11 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies 12 only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this 13 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before 14 15 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs before the effective date. 16 An offense committed before the effective date of this 17 (b) Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, 18 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003. 20
