## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2	relating to the requirement that governmental public notices be
3	published in Spanish-language newspapers.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 5, Government Code, is amended
6	by adding Chapter 560 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 560. PUBLICATION OF PUBLIC NOTICES IN SPANISH-LANGUAGE
8	<u>NEWSPAPER</u>
9	Sec. 560.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "Public notice" means any notice that must be
11	provided to the general public under Chapter 4, Election Code,
12	Chapter 551 of this code, or other law by:
13	(A) a state agency or a state officer or
14	<pre>employee; or</pre>
15	(B) a political subdivision of this state or an
16	officer or employee of a political subdivision.
17	(2) "Spanish-language newspaper" means a newspaper
18	that is printed in Spanish.
19	Sec. 560.002. PUBLICATION IN SPANISH-LANGUAGE NEWSPAPER BY
20	STATE AGENCY OR OFFICER. A state agency or a state officer or
21	employee with responsibility for publishing a public notice shall
22	publish the notice in Spanish in a Spanish-language newspaper of
23	general circulation in each county in which:
24	(1) the agency, officer, or employee is required to

- 2 (2) more than 50 percent of the population is of
- 3 <u>Hispanic origin; and</u>
- 4 (3) there is a Spanish-language newspaper of general
- 5 circulation.
- 6 Sec. 560.003. PUBLICATION IN SPANISH-LANGUAGE NEWSPAPER BY
- 7 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION. (a) This section applies only to:
- 8 (1) a political subdivision, other than a county, any
- 9 portion of which is located in a county in which more than 50
- 10 percent of the population is of Hispanic origin; or
- 11 (2) a county in which more than 50 percent of the
- 12 population is of Hispanic origin.
- 13 (b) A political subdivision or an officer or employee of a
- 14 political subdivision with responsibility for publishing a public
- notice shall publish the notice in Spanish in a Spanish-language
- 16 newspaper of general circulation in each county in which:
- 17 (1) the political subdivision is located; and
- 18 <u>(2) there is a Spanish-language newspaper of general</u>
- 19 circulation.
- Sec. 560.004. NOTICE IN ADDITION TO NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER
- 21 OTHER LAW. Notice published under this chapter is in addition to
- 22 <u>notice required by other law.</u>
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
