5 SECTION 1. Sections 172.021(b) and (e), Election Code, are

6 amended to read as follows:

- (b) An application must, in addition to complying with Section 141.031, be accompanied by the appropriate filing fee or [τ
- 9 instead of the filing fee, a petition in lieu of the filing fee
- 10 that satisfies the requirements prescribed by Section 141.062. A
- 11 political party may not require payment of a fee as a condition to
- 12 applying for a place on the ballot as a candidate for county chair
- 13 or precinct chair.

- 14 (e) A candidate for an office specified by Section
- 15 172.024(a)(8), (10), or (12), or for justice of the peace in a
- 16 county with a population of more than 850,000, who chooses to pay
- 17 the filing fee must also accompany the application with a petition
- for a place on the primary ballot as a candidate for judicial office
- 19 that complies with the requirements prescribed for the petition
- 20 authorized by Subsection (b), except that the minimum number of
- 21 signatures that must appear on the petition required by this
- 22 subsection is 250. If the candidate chooses to file the petition
- 23 authorized by Subsection (b) in lieu [instead] of the filing fee,

- 1 increased by 250. Signatures on a petition filed under this
- 2 subsection or Subsection (b) by a candidate covered by this

- 4 or courthouse annex.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
