A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the application of the open meetings law and the public 3 information law to certain meetings and information regarding plans for responding to an act of terrorism. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 551, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 551.090 to read as follows: 7 Sec. 551.090. CERTAIN DELIBERATIONS OF COMMISSIONERS COURT 8 OR MUNICIPAL GOVERNING BODY. This chapter does not require a 9 county commissioners court or a municipal governing body to conduct 10 11 an open meeting to deliberate the details, or specific occasions 12 for implementation, of a plan for responding to an act of terrorism. SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is 13 14 amended by adding Section 552.145 to read as follows: Sec. 552.145. EXCEPTION: CERTAIN RESPONSE 15 PLANS OF MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY. Information is excepted from 16 the requirements of Section 552.021 if the information relates to a 17 plan of a municipality or county for responding to an act of 18 terrorism and is collected, assembled, or maintained by the 19 department of the municipality or county responsible for emergency 20 21 management or emergency responses. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22

22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

2 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
