4	SECTION 1. Section 277.001, Election Code, is amended to

6	Sec. 277.001. APPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. This chapter
7	applies to a petition authorized or required to be filed under a law
8	outside this code in connection with an election, not including
9	[except] a petition for a local option election held under the
10	Alcoholic Beverage Code, without regard to whether the law
11	governing the election specifically references this chapter,
12	including local option elections under
13	(1) Chapters 43, 78, 143, and 146, Agriculture Code;
14	(2) Chapters 215, 231, 344, and 363, Local Government
15	Code; and
16	(3) Chapter 2001, Occupations Code.
17	SECTION 2. Section 277.002 (e), Election Code, is amended
18	to read as follows:
19	(e) A petition signature is invalid if the signer signed the
20	petition earlier than the 180th day before the date the petition is
21	filed. In regard to a petition to which this chapter applies, the
22	petition must be filed with the appropriate authority not more than
23	180 days after it is issued, notwithstanding a conflicting law or

ordinance providing for the petition.
