1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the use of TexasOnline by state agencies.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 2054.111, Government Code, is amended by
1-13 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (g) to read as
1-14 follows:

1-15 (d) A state agency that uses [~~chooses to use~~] the project
1-16 [~~under Subsection (b)~~] shall comply with rules adopted by the
1-17 department, including any rules regarding:

1-18 (1) the appearance of the agency's Internet site and
1-19 the ease with which the site can be used; [~~and~~]

1-20 (2) the use of the authority seal; and

1-21 (3) marketing efforts under Subsection (g).

1-22 (g) A state agency that uses the project shall assist the
1-23 authority with marketing efforts regarding the use of the project.

1-24 SECTION 2. Section 2054.125, Government Code, is amended by
1-25 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

1-26 (d) Each state agency that maintains a generally accessible
1-27 Internet site and that uses TexasOnline shall include a link to
1-28 TexasOnline on the front page of the site.

1-29 SECTION 3. Subchapter I, Chapter 2054, Government Code, as
1-30 added by Chapter 342, Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular
1-31 Session, 2001, is amended by adding Section 2054.268 to read as
1-32 follows:

1-33 Sec. 2054.268. MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS. For purposes
1-34 of this chapter, the renewal of a motor vehicle registration is a
1-35 state service.

1-36 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-37 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-38 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-40 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
