## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to performance standards for toilets sold in the state.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 372.002, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Subsection (b-1) and amending Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (b-1) In addition to the requirements of Subsection (b), for
  8 a gravity flush toilet, the maximum flow may not exceed 2.0 gallons
  9 of water per flushing if a non-early closure flapper is installed or
  10 if the water level in the tank is raised to the maximum allowable
  11 height of the overflow tube.
- 12 (c) The commission shall make and maintain a current list of 13 plumbing fixtures that are certified to the commission by the 14 manufacturer or importer to meet the water saving performance standards established by  $\underline{Subsections}$  [ $\underline{Subsection}$ ] (b) and (b-1). 15 To have a plumbing fixture included on the list, a manufacturer or 16 importer must supply to the commission, in the form prescribed by 17 18 the commission, the identification and the performance specifications of the plumbing fixture. The manufacturer or 19 importer must submit test results from an independent laboratory 20 21 to verify that the toilet described by Subsection (b-1) meets the standards of that subsection. The commission may test a listed 22 fixture to determine the accuracy of the manufacturer's or 23 importer's certification and shall remove from the list a fixture 24

- 1 the commission finds to be inaccurately certified.
- 2 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 3 (b) The change in law made by this Act applies only to a 4 toilet described by Section 372.002(b-1), Health and Safety Code, 5 as added by this Act, that is sold, offered for sale, distributed, 6 or imported into this state for use in this state on or after
- 7 September 1, 2005.
