No. 837 1 (iii) causes the sexual organ of a child to 2 contact or penetrate the mouth, anus, or sexual organ of another person, including the actor; 3 (iv) causes the anus of a child to contact 4 the mouth, anus, or sexual organ of another person, including the 5 6 actor; or 7 (v) causes the mouth of a child to contact the anus or sexual organ of another person, including the actor; and 8 9 (2) if: 10 (A) the person: 11 (i) causes serious bodily injury or attempts to cause the death of the victim or another person in the 12 13 course of the same criminal episode; (ii) by acts or words places the victim in 14 15 fear that death, serious bodily injury, or kidnapping will be 16 imminently inflicted on any person; 17 (iii) by acts or words occurring in the 18 presence of the victim threatens to cause the death, serious bodily injury, or kidnapping of any person; 19 (iv) uses or exhibits a deadly weapon in the 20 course of the same criminal episode; 21 22 (v) acts in concert with another who engages in conduct described by Subdivision (1) directed toward the 23 same victim and occurring during the course of the same criminal 24 25 episode; or (vi) administers 26 or provides 27 flunitrazepam, otherwise known as rohypnol, gamma hydroxybutyrate,

No. 837 or ketamine to the victim of the offense with the intent of 1 2 facilitating the commission of the offense; the victim is younger than 14 years of age; or 3 (B) the victim is an elderly individual or a 4 (C) 5 disabled individual [65 years of age or older]. 6 (b) In this section: (1) "Child" [, "child"] has the meaning assigned [that 7 term] by Section 22.011(c). 8 (2) "Elderly individual" and "disabled individual" 9 have the meanings assigned by Section 22.04(c). 10 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003. 11 The change in law made by this Act applies only to an 12 (b) offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 13 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is covered 14 by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former 15 16 law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this 17 subsection, an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that 18 19 date.
