1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the regulation of certain extra job coordinators by the
1-9 Texas Commission on Private Security.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subdivision (7), Section 1702.002, Occupations
1-12 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (7) "Extra job coordinator" means a peace officer who:

1-14 (A) is employed full-time by the state or a
1-15 political subdivision of the state [~~municipality~~]; and

1-16 (B) schedules other peace officers to provide
1-17 guard, patrolman, or watchman services in a private capacity who
1-18 are:

1-19 (i) employed full-time by the state or a
1-20 political subdivision of the state [~~municipality~~]; and

1-21 (ii) not employed by the extra job
1-22 coordinator.

1-23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-27 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
