9	MUNICIPALITY. (a) A municipality by ordinance may establish
10	regulations permitting the municipality to refuse to enter into a
11	contract or other transaction with a person indebted to the
12	municipality.
13	(b) It is not a violation of this chapter for a
14	municipality, under regulations adopted under Subsection (a), to
15	refuse to award a contract to or enter into a transaction with an
16	apparent low bidder or successful proposer that is indebted to the
17	municipality.
18	(c) In this section, "person" includes an individual, sole
19	proprietorship, corporation, nonprofit corporation, partnership,
20	joint venture, limited liability company, and any other entity that
21	proposes or otherwise seeks to enter into a contract or other
22	transaction with the municipality requiring approval by the
23	governing body of the municipality.
24	SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 262, Local Government

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Code, is amended by adding Section 262.0276 to read as follows:
Sec. 262.0276. CONTRACT WITH PERSON INDEBTED TO COUNTY.
(a) By an order adopted and entered in the minutes of the
commissioners court and after notice is published in a newspaper of
general circulation in the county, the commissioners court may
adopt rules permitting the county to refuse to enter into a contract
or other transaction with a person indebted to the county.

8 (b) It is not a violation of this subchapter for a county, 9 <u>under rules adopted under Subsection (a), to refuse to award a</u> 10 <u>contract to or enter into a transaction with an apparent low bidder</u> 11 <u>or successful proposer that is indebted to the county.</u>

12 (c) In this section, "person" includes an individual, sole 13 proprietorship, corporation, nonprofit corporation, partnership, 14 joint venture, limited liability company, and any other entity that 15 proposes or otherwise seeks to enter into a contract or other 16 transaction with the county requiring approval by the commissioners 17 court.

SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 44, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 44.044 to read as follows:

20 <u>Sec. 44.044. CONTRACT WITH PERSON INDEBTED TO SCHOOL</u> 21 <u>DISTRICT. (a) The board of trustees of a school district by</u> 22 <u>resolution may establish regulations permitting the school</u> 23 <u>district to refuse to enter into a contract or other transaction</u> 24 <u>with a person indebted to the school district.</u>

(b) It is not a violation of this subchapter for a school
 district, under regulations adopted under Subsection (a), to refuse
 to award a contract to or enter into a transaction with an apparent

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1	low bidder or successful proposer that is indebted to the school
2	<u>district.</u>
3	(c) In this section, "person" includes an individual, sole
4	proprietorship, corporation, nonprofit corporation, partnership,
5	joint venture, limited liability company, and any other entity that
6	proposes or otherwise seeks to enter into a contract or other
7	transaction with the school district requiring approval by the
8	board.
9	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
