## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to allowing local governments and school districts to 3 prohibit contracts with delinquent taxpayers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 252, Local Government
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 252.0436 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 252.0436. CONTRACT WITH PERSON OR FIRM INDEBTED TO
- 8 MUNICIPALITY. (a) A municipality by ordinance may establish
- 9 regulations permitting the municipality to refuse to enter into a
- 10 contract with a person indebted to the municipality.
- 11 (b) It is not a violation of this chapter for a
- 12 <u>municipality</u>, under regulations adopted under Subsection (a), to
- 13 refuse to award a contract to an apparent low bidder or successful
- 14 proposer who is indebted to the municipality.
- 15 (c) In this section, "person" includes an individual, sole
- 16 proprietorship, corporation, nonprofit corporation, partnership,
- joint venture, limited liability company, and any other entity that
- 18 proposes or otherwise seeks to enter into a contract with the
- 19 municipality requiring approval by the governing body of the
- 20 <u>municipality</u>.

- 21 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 262, Local Government
- 22 Code, is amended by adding Section 262.0276 to read as follows:
- Sec. 262.0276. CONTRACT WITH PERSON OR FIRM INDEBTED TO
- 24 COUNTY. (a) By an order adopted and entered in the minutes of the

- 1 commissioners court and after notice is published in a newspaper of
- 2 general circulation in the county, the commissioners court may
- 3 adopt rules permitting the county to refuse to enter into a contract
- 4 with a person indebted to the county.
- 5 (b) It is not a violation of this subchapter for a county,
- 6 under rules adopted under Subsection (a), to refuse to award a
- 7 contract to an apparent low bidder or successful proposer who is
- 8 indebted to the county.
- 9 <u>(c) In this section, "person" includes an individual, sole</u>
- 10 proprietorship, corporation, nonprofit corporation, partnership,
- joint venture, limited liability company, and any other entity that
- 12 proposes or otherwise seeks to enter into a contract with the county
- 13 requiring approval by the commissioners court.
- 14 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 44, Education Code, is
- amended by adding Section 44.044 to read as follows:
- 16 Sec. 44.044. CONTRACT WITH PERSON OR FIRM INDEBTED TO
- 17 SCHOOL DISTRICT. (a) The board of trustees of a school district by
- 18 resolution may establish regulations permitting the school
- 19 district to refuse to enter into a contract with a person indebted
- 20 to the school district.
- 21 (b) It is not a violation of this subchapter for a school
- 22 <u>district</u>, under regulations adopted under Subsection (a), to refuse
- 23 to award a contract to an apparent low bidder or successful proposer
- 24 who is indebted to the school district.
- (c) In this section, "person" includes an individual, sole
- 26 proprietorship, corporation, nonprofit corporation, partnership,
- joint venture, limited liability company, and any other entity that

- 1 proposes or otherwise seeks to enter into a contract with the school
- 2 <u>district requiring approval by the board.</u>
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
