- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 61.39, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 61.39. MAY CONTEST APPLICATION. Any person may
- 8 contest the facts stated in an application for a license to
- 9 distribute, manufacture, or sell beer at retail, or the applicant's
- 10 right to secure a license, if $\underline{\text{the person}}$ [$\underline{\text{he}}$] gives security for all
- 11 costs which may be incurred in the contest if the case should be
- 12 decided in favor of the applicant. No security for costs may be
- 13 required of an officer of a county or incorporated city or town or
- 14 an elected officer of the state or federal government.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
