S.B. No. 892

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the appointment of the board of managers of certain
3 emergency communications districts.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 772, Health and Safety
6 Code, is amended by adding Section 772.002 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 772.002. JOINT APPOINTMENTS TO BOARD OF MANAGERS. An
8 appointment to a board of managers under this chapter that is made
9 jointly by more than one municipality or other entity shall be made
10 by majority vote of the municipalities or other entities entitled
11 to make the appointment.

12 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an appointment to a
13 board of managers under Chapter 772, Health and Safety Code, made on
14 or after the effective date of this Act. An appointment to a board
15 of managers made before the effective date of this Act is governed
16 by the law in effect at the time the appointment is made, and that
17 law is continued in effect for that purpose.

18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
22 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
