1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsection (c), Section 521.205, Transportation  
1-12 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (c) The rules must provide a method by which:

1-14 (1) approval of a course is obtained; [~~and~~]

1-15 (2) an applicant submits proof of completion of the  
1-16 course; and

1-17 (3) approval for delivering course materials by an  
1-18 alternative method, including electronic means, is obtained.

1-19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
