5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. The heading to Section 552.308, Government Code,
7	is amended to read as follows:
8	Sec. 552.308. TIMELINESS OF ACTION BY UNITED STATES MAIL,
9	[OR] INTERAGENCY MAIL, OR COMMON OR CONTRACT CARRIER.
10	SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 552.308, Government
11	Code, is amended to read as follows:
12	(a) When this subchapter requires a request, notice, or
13	other document to be submitted or otherwise given to a person within
14	a specified period, the requirement is met in a timely fashion if
15	the document is sent to the person by first class United States mail
16	or common or contract carrier properly addressed with postage or
17	handling charges prepaid and:
18	(1) it bears a post office cancellation mark <u>or a</u>
19	receipt mark of a common or contract carrier indicating a time
20	within that period; or
21	(2) the person required to submit or otherwise give
22	the document furnishes satisfactory proof that it was deposited in
23	the mail or with a common or contract carrier within that period.
24	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

1	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
3	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
4	Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
