- 7 Sec. 12.44. REDUCTION OF [STATE JAIL] FELONY PUNISHMENT TO
- 8 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHMENT. (a) A court may punish a defendant who is
- 9 convicted of a felony of the third degree or a state jail felony by
- 10 imposing the confinement permissible as punishment for a Class A
- 11 misdemeanor if, after considering the gravity and circumstances of
- 12 the felony committed and the history, character, and rehabilitative
- 13 needs of the defendant, the court finds that such punishment would
- 14 best serve the ends of justice.
- 15 (b) When a court is authorized to impose punishment for a
- lesser category of offense as provided in Subsection (a), the court
- 17 may authorize the prosecuting attorney to prosecute initially for
- 18 the lesser category of offense.
- 19 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 20 only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 21 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before
- the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs

- 24 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this

- 1 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- 2 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
