16	(3) has not previously been convicted of, or
17	adjudicated as having engaged in delinquent conduct constituting, a
18	felony offense, including an offense under Section 42.072, Penal
19	<u>Code.</u>
20	(b) The attorney general by rule shall establish and
21	administer through the service a project in which local and
22	statewide programs provide intervention services to eligible
23	sexual assault offenders.
24	(c) The attorney general shall contract with local and

1	statewide programs who apply and are qualified to offer services
2	under this section.
3	(d) The attorney general shall establish procedures for an
4	eligible sexual assault offender receiving services from a program
5	under this section to pay to the program all costs incurred in
6	providing the services to the offender. The offender shall pay
7	those costs in accordance with the procedures established under
8	this subsection.
9	SECTION 2. (a) The office of the attorney general shall
10	adopt rules as necessary under Section 420.0065, Government Code,
11	as added by this Act, not later than December 1, 2003.
12	(b) The office of the attorney general shall establish the
13	sexual assault offender project required by Section 420.0065,
14	Government Code, as added by this Act, not later than September 1,
15	2004.
16	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
