A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the eligibility of certain children for certain health
- 3 benefit coverage.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 3(a), Article 21.24-2, Insurance Code,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Each health benefit plan that conditions coverage for a
- 8 child up to 25 years of age on the child's being a full-time student
- 9 at an educational institution shall provide the coverage for an
- 10 entire academic term during which the child begins as a full-time
- 11 student and remains enrolled, regardless of whether the number of
- 12 hours of instruction for which the child is enrolled is reduced to a
- 13 level that changes the child's academic status to less than that of
- 14 a full-time student. Additionally, the health benefit plan shall
- 15 provide the coverage continuously until the 10th day of instruction
- of the subsequent academic term on which date the health benefit
- 17 plan may terminate coverage of the child if the child does not
- 18 return to full-time student status before that date. [A health
- 19 benefit plan may not condition coverage for a child younger than 25
- 20 years of age on the child's being enrolled at an educational
- 21 institution.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and
- 23 applies only to a health benefit plan that is delivered, issued for
- 24 delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2004. A plan that is

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- 1 delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2004,
- 2 is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
- 3 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 4 that purpose.
