## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the manner of issuance of, and use of information in an
- 3 application for, a driver's license or personal identification
- 4 certificate issued by the Department of Public Safety of the State
- 5 of Texas.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 521.001, Transportation
- 8 Code, is amended by adding Subdivisions (9) and (10) to read as
- 9 follows:
- 10 (9) "Biometric identification" means any automated
- 11 method of identifying a person based on a physiological
- 12 characteristic, including facial recognition, thumbprinting, and
- 13 <u>fingerprinting.</u>
- 14 (10) "Biometric identifier" means any physiological
- 15 characteristic used in biometric identification.
- SECTION 2. The heading to Section 521.044, Transportation
- 17 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 521.044. USE OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER INFORMATION
- 19 [FOR CHILD SUPPORT COLLECTION].
- SECTION 3. Subsection (a), Section 521.044, Transportation
- 21 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 22 (a) Information provided on a driver's license application
- 23 that relates to the applicant's social security number may be used
- 24 only by the department or disclosed only to:

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- 1 (1) the child support enforcement division of the
- 2 attorney general's office;
- 3 (2) another state entity responsible for enforcing the
- 4 payment of child support; [or]
- 5 (3) the United States Selective Service System as
- 6 provided by Section 521.147; or
- 7 (4) a law enforcement or criminal justice agency for
- 8 investigative purposes.
- 9 SECTION 4. Subchapter C, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- is amended by adding Section 521.058 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 521.058. IDENTITY AUTHENTICATION SYSTEM. (a) The
- 12 department shall establish an identification system using
- 13 <u>biometric identification based on any biometric identifier of an</u>
- 14 applicant that is collected by the department.
- 15 (b) The department shall authenticate the biometric
- 16 identifier provided by an applicant for a personal identification
- 17 certificate, driver's license, or commercial driver's license or
- 18 permit to ensure that the applicant:
- 19 (1) is issued only one original license, permit, or
- 20 certificate;
- 21 (2) does not fraudulently obtain a duplicate license,
- 22 permit, or certificate; and
- 23 (3) does not commit other fraud in connection with the
- 24 application for a license, permit, or certificate.
- 25 SECTION 5. Subsection (d), Section 521.101, Transportation
- 26 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 27 (d) The department may require each applicant for an

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- 1 original, renewal, or duplicate personal identification
- 2 certificate to furnish to the department the information required
- 3 by Section 521.142, except the department may not require the
- 4 applicant to provide the applicant's social security number.
- 5 SECTION 6. Subsection (b), Section 521.142, Transportation
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The application must include:
- 8 (1) any biometric identifier specified by the
- 9 department [the thumbprints of the applicant or, if thumbprints
- 10 cannot be taken, the index fingerprints of the applicant]; [and]
- 11 (2) a brief description of the applicant; and
- 12 (3) the applicant's social security number.
- SECTION 7. Section 521.421, Transportation Code, is amended
- 14 by amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsections (i) and
- 15 (j) to read as follows:
- 16 (a) The fee for issuance or renewal of a license not
- otherwise provided for by this section is \$30 [\$24].
- 18 (b) An applicant applying for issuance of a Class M license
- or additional authorization to operate a motorcycle shall pay an
- 20 additional \$15 fee for the required application. The fee for
- 21 renewal of a Class M license or for renewal of a license that
- includes authorization to operate a motorcycle is \$38 [\$32].
- (i) Before September 1, 2005, the department shall deposit
- \$6 of each fee collected under Subsections (a) and (b) to the credit
- of a separate account in the general revenue fund. Money in that
- 26 account must be appropriated to the department only to support the
- 27 department's reengineering of the driver's license system.

- 1 (j) After August 31, 2005, of each fee collected under
- 2 Subsections (a) and (b) the department shall deposit:
- 3 (1) \$2 to the credit of a separate account in the
- 4 general revenue fund to be appropriated to the department only to
- 5 replace, maintain, or support the driver's license system; and
- 6 (2) \$4 to the credit of the state highway fund.
- 7 SECTION 8. Subsection (c), Section 522.021, Transportation
- 8 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 (c) The application must meet the requirements of an
- 10 application under <u>Sections</u> [Section] 521.141 and 521.142 and must
- 11 be accompanied by the fee required under Section 522.029. The
- 12 department may require documentary evidence to verify the
- information required by Subsection (a).
- SECTION 9. Section 730.010, Transportation Code, is amended
- 15 to read as follows:
- 16 Sec. 730.010. DISCLOSURE OF THUMB OR FINGER IMAGES
- 17 PROHIBITED. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter,
- if an agency obtains an image of an individual's thumb or finger in
- 19 connection with the issuance of a license, permit, or certificate
- 20 to the individual, the agency may:
- 21 (1) use the image to authenticate identity [enly in
- 22 connection with the issuance of the license, permit, or
- 23 certificate]; and
- 24 (2) disclose the image only if disclosure is expressly
- 25 authorized by law.
- SECTION 10. Subsection (f), Section 521.421,
- 27 Transportation Code, as added by Chapter 1156, Acts of the 75th

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- 1 Legislature, Regular Session, 1997, and Subsection (f), Section
- 521.421, Transportation Code, as added by Chapter 1372, Acts of the
- 3 75th Legislature, Regular Session, 1997, are repealed.
- 4 SECTION 11. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 5 (b) The change in law made by this Act to Section 521.421,
- 6 Transportation Code, applies only to the fee for the issuance or
- 7 renewal of a driver's license that is applied for on or after
- 8 September 1, 2003.
- 9 (c) A driver's license or renewal of a driver's license
- 10 applied for before September 1, 2003, is covered by the law in
- 11 effect on the date the application for the driver's license or
- 12 renewal was made, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 13 purpose.
