- 5 SECTION 1. Section 521.165, Transportation Code, is amended 6 by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) This section does not allow the director to waive a
  8 driving test for an applicant who has completed a driver education
  9 course approved by the department under Section 521.205.
- SECTION 2. Section 521.205(d), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 12 (d) Except as otherwise provided by this chapter,

  13 completion [Completion] of a driver education course approved under

  14 this section has the same effect under this chapter as completion of

  15 a driver education course approved by the Texas Education Agency.
- SECTION 3. Section 521.421, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Subsections (i) and (j) to read as follows:
- (i) In addition to the fee in Subsection (c), an applicant applying for original issuance of a provisional license who has completed a driver education course under Section 521.205 must pay a \$5 examination fee for the examination required by Section 521.161(b)(2).
- 23 (j) The fee collected under Subsection (i) must be deposited

to the credit of a special account in the general revenue fund and
