1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the regulation of stormwater management by certain
1-11 counties.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 423.001, Local Government Code, is
1-14 amended to read as follows:

1-15 Sec. 423.001. COUNTY OR DISTRICT SUBJECT TO CHAPTER. This
1-16 chapter applies only to:

1-17 (1) a county with a population of 2.8 million or more;
1-18 [~~or~~]

1-19 (2) a district or authority created under Section 59,
1-20 Article XVI, Texas Constitution, that:

1-21 (A) has boundaries coterminous with a county
1-22 described by Subdivision (1); and

1-23 (B) is authorized to provide stormwater drainage
1-24 and flood control facilities; or

1-25 (3) a county with a population of more than 1.3 million
1-26 for which the primary source of drinking water is an underground
1-27 aquifer.

1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-30 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-31 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
