- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 562.108, Occupations
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A Class A or Class C pharmacy may maintain controlled
- 8 substances and dangerous drugs in an emergency medication kit used
- 9 at an institution licensed under Chapter 242 or 252, Health and
- 10 Safety Code. <u>A United States Department of Veterans Affairs</u>
- 11 pharmacy or another federally operated pharmacy may maintain
- 12 <u>controlled substances and dangerous drugs in an emergency</u>
- 13 medication kit used at an institution that is licensed under
- 14 Chapter 242, Health and Safety Code, and is a veterans home, as
- defined by Section 164.002, Natural Resources Code. The controlled
- 16 substances and dangerous drugs may be used only for the emergency
- 17 medication needs of a resident at the [that] institution.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
