## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the maintenance at certain institutions of controlled substances and dangerous drugs in an emergency medication kit.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Section 562.108, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

Notwithstanding Subsection (a), a veterans home, (c) defined by Section 164.002, Natural Resources Code, that is licensed under Chapter 242, Health and Safety Code, may contract with a United States Department of Veterans Affairs pharmacy or another federally operated pharmacy for that pharmacy to maintain controlled substances and dangerous drugs in an emergency medical kit used at the home. The controlled substances and dangerous drugs may be used only for the emergency medication needs of a resident of the home.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
