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- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 615.073, Government 6 Code, is amended to read as follows: 7
- (b) An eligible surviving spouse of a deceased individual 8
- listed in Section 615.071 who was employed by a political 9
- subdivision of the state is entitled to purchase continued health 10
- insurance benefits from the political subdivision that employed the 11
- 12 deceased individual, including health coverage:
- 13 (1) provided by or through a political subdivision
- 14 under:
- 15 (A) a health insurance policy or health benefit
- plan written by a health insurer; or 16
- a self-insured health benefits plan; or 17
- (2) under Chapter 172, Local Government Code. 18
- SECTION 2. This Act is intended to clarify the law in effect 19
- and being administered immediately before the effective date of 20
- this Act. 21
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. 24
