A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to documentation in certain transactions involving a
- 3 pawnbroker.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 371.157, Finance Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 371.157. PAWN TICKET. A pawnbroker, at the time a pawn
- 8 transaction is entered, shall deliver to the pledgor a pawn ticket
- 9 or other memorandum that clearly shows:
- 10 (1) the name and address of the pawnshop;
- 11 (2) the pledgor's name, address, and physical
- 12 description and a driver's license number, military identification
- 13 number, identification certificate number, or other official
- 14 number that can identify the pledgor;
- 15 (3) the date of the transaction;
- 16 (4) an identification and description of the pledged
- 17 goods, including serial numbers if reasonably available;
- 18 (5) the amount of cash advanced or credit extended to
- 19 the pledgor, designated as "Amount Financed";
- 20 (6) the amount of the pawn service charge, designated
- 21 as "Finance Charge";
- (7) the total amount, consisting of the amount
- 23 financed plus the finance charge, that must be paid to redeem the
- 24 pledged goods on the maturity date, designated as "Total of

- 1 Payments";
- 2 (8) the "Annual Percentage Rate," computed according
- 3 to regulations issued by the Federal Reserve Board under the Truth
- 4 in Lending Act (15 U.S.C. Section 1601 et seq.), as amended;
- 5 (9) the maturity date of the pawn transaction; and
- 6 (10) a statement that:
- 7 (A) the pledgor is not obligated to redeem the
- 8 pledged goods; and
- 9 (B) the pledged goods may be forfeited to the
- 10 pawnbroker on the 31st [61st] day after the maturity date.
- 11 SECTION 2. Subsection (b), Section 371.174, Finance Code,
- 12 is amended to read as follows:
- 13 (b) Identification is acceptable only if it contains a
- 14 photograph of the pledgor or seller and is:
- 15 (1) a state driver's license;
- 16 (2) a state identification card;
- 17 (3) a passport;
- 18 (4) a military identification;
- 19 (5) a certificate of identification from the Mexican
- 20 Consulate, certificado de matricula consular [nonresident alien
- 21 border crossing card]; or
- 22 (6) <u>identification issued by the agency of the United</u>
- 23 States responsible for citizenship and immigration [a resident
- 24 alien border crossing card; or
- 25 [(7) a United States Immigration and Naturalization
- 26 Service identification].
- 27 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
