2	relating to the definition of an energy emergency.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subdivision (3), Section 418.004, Government
5	Code, is amended to read as follows:
6	(3) "Energy emergency" means a temporary statewide,
7	regional, or local shortage of petroleum <u>, natural gas,</u> or liquid
8	<u>fuel [fuels]</u> energy supplies that makes emergency measures
9	necessary to reduce demand or allocate supply.
10	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
11	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
12	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
13	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
14	Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
