4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 593, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 593.0225 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 593.0225. CRITERIA FOR VOLUNTARY ADMISSION; WAITING
8	LIST. (a) The board by rule shall provide that a state school
9	shall admit any person with mental retardation for whom an
10	application for voluntary admission is filed, regardless of the
11	recommendation of the interdisciplinary team, if:
12	(1) the state school has sufficient bed space for the
13	person to be admitted for care;
14	(2) the person is eligible to receive Medicaid
15	benefits; and
16	(3) the state school would provide the least
17	restrictive environment appropriate to the person's care.
18	(b) Each state school shall maintain a waiting list of
19	persons who desire voluntary admission to a state school and who
20	were denied admission because of lack of bed space.
21	(c) The department shall ensure that persons seeking state
22	services for a person with mental retardation are informed of the
23	criteria established in rules adopted under Subsection (a), of the
24	waiting list required by Subsection (b), and of the addresses and

telephone numbers of each state school. 1 2 (d) The board may adopt rules to facilitate the application 3 process for voluntary admission to a state school, the maintenance of the waiting list required by Subsection (b), and the provision of 4 5 information as required by Subsection (c). SECTION 2. The Texas Department of Mental Health and Mental 6 7 Retardation shall ensure that persons on a waiting list maintained by a mental retardation authority for admission to a state school 8 9 are informed of: criteria established in rules adopted under 10 (1)Section 593.0225, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act; 11 (2) the waiting lists required by that section; and 12 (3) the address and telephone number of each state 13 school. 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and 15 16 applies to an application for voluntary admission filed on or after 17 that date. An application for voluntary admission filed before that date is governed by the law in effect on the date the 18 application was filed, and that law is continued in effect for that 19 20 purpose.
