A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a statistical or demographic analysis conducted by the 3 Texas Legislative Council for a state agency and to information collected by the council in the course of performing the analysis. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 2113, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 2113.108 to read as follows: 7 8 Sec. 2113.108. CERTAIN STUDIES INVOLVING STATISTICAL OR DEMOGRAPHIC ANALYSIS. (a) A state agency may not use appropriated 9 money to contract with a consultant or other nongovernmental entity 10 11 to perform or assist the agency in performing a statistical or 12 demographic analysis of information collected by or for the agency in the course of conducting a study that the agency is required to 13 14 conduct under state law unless the agency first contacts the Texas Legislative Council to determine whether the resources of the 15 16 council are available to perform or assist the agency in performing that analysis. For purposes of this section, performing a 17 statistical or demographic analysis of information in the course of 18 conducting a study includes designing the analysis and collecting 19 the information required for purposes of the study. 20 21 (b) If the Texas Legislative Council determines that 22 council resources are available to perform or assist the agency in

23 performing all or part of the statistical or demographic analysis,
24 the agency must contract with the council to perform or assist the

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1 agency in performing that analysis to the extent that the council 2 determines that council resources are available to the agency. SECTION 2. Chapter 323, Government Code, is amended by 3 4 adding Section 323.020 to read as follows: 5 Sec. 323.020. CONTRACTS TO PERFORM STATISTICAL OR 6 DEMOGRAPHIC ANALYSIS; CONFIDENTIALITY OF INFORMATION NOT AFFECTED. 7 (a) The council may determine whether and the extent to which 8 council resources are available to perform or assist a state agency 9 in performing a statistical or demographic analysis of information 10 as described by Section 2113.108. (b) Information that the council collects in relation to the 11

statistical or demographic analysis that is confidential under 12 state or federal law does not lose its confidential character 13 because of its collection by the council, without regard to whether 14 15 the council collected the information indirectly through the state agency or directly from another governmental or nongovernmental 16 17 entity. An entity that voluntarily provides information to the council for purposes of the analysis does not waive any exception 18 from required disclosure or any privilege not to disclose the 19 information, and the confidential character of the information is 20 21 not affected by that action of the entity.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
