| 5 | SECTION 1. Section 51.007, Human Resources Code, is amended |
| 6 | to read as follows: |
| 7 | Sec. 51.007. CONFIDENTIALITY. The department may not |
| 8 | disclose any information [gained through reports, collected case |
| 9 | data, or inspections] that would identify: |
| 10 | (1) a particular <u>family violence</u> center <u>location;</u> |
| 11 | (2) a board member of a family violence center or |
| 12 | family violence special project; or |
| 13 | (3) a person working at or receiving services through |
| 14 | [at] a family violence center <u>or family violence special project</u> . |
| 15 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives |
| 16 | a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as |
| 17 | provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this |
| 18 | Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this |
| 19 | Act takes effect September 1, 2003. |
