1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the confidentiality of information associated with  
1-9 family violence centers.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 51.007, Human Resources Code, is amended  
1-12 to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 51.007. CONFIDENTIALITY. The department may not  
1-14 disclose any information [~~gained through reports, collected case~~  
1-15 ~~data, or inspections~~] that would identify:

1-16 (1) a particular family violence center location;

1-17 (2) a board member of a family violence center or  
1-18 family violence special project; or

1-19 (3) a person working at or receiving services through  
1-20 [~~at~~] a family violence center or family violence special project.

1-21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-25 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
