- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter GG, Chapter 2306,
- 6 Government Code, as added by Chapter 1367, Acts of the 77th
- 7 Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 SUBCHAPTER GG. COLONIA MODEL SUBDIVISION AND DOWN PAYMENT

9 ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS [PROGRAM]

- 10 SECTION 2. Section 2306.781, Government Code, as added by
- 11 Chapter 1367, Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001,
- 12 is amended to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 2306.781. <u>DEFINITIONS</u> [<u>DEFINITION</u>]. In this
- 14 subchapter:

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- 15 (1) "Down payment assistance program" means the
- 16 colonia down payment program established under this subchapter.
- 17 (2) $[\tau]$ "Model subdivision program" means the colonia
- 18 model subdivision program established under this subchapter.
- 19 SECTION 3. The heading to Section 2306.782, Government
- 20 Code, as added by Chapter 1367, Acts of the 77th Legislature,
- 21 Regular Session, 2001, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 2306.782. ESTABLISHMENT OF MODEL SUBDIVISION PROGRAM.
- SECTION 4. Section 2306.783(a), Government Code, as added
- 24 by Chapter 1367, Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session,

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- 1 2001, is amended to read as follows:
- 2 (a) The department shall establish a colonia model
- 3 subdivision revolving loan fund in the department. Money in the
- 4 fund may be used only for purposes of the model subdivision program.
- 5 SECTION 5. Section 2306.785, Government Code, as added by
- 6 Chapter 1367, Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001,
- 7 is amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 2306.785. MODEL SUBDIVISION PROGRAM LOANS. (a) The
- 9 department may make loans under the model subdivision program only
- 10 to:
- 11 (1) colonia self-help centers established under
- 12 Subchapter Z; and
- 13 (2) community housing development organizations
- 14 certified by the department.
- 15 (b) A loan made under the <u>model subdivision</u> program may be
- 16 used only for the payment of:
- 17 (1) costs associated with the purchase of real
- 18 property;
- 19 (2) costs of surveying, platting, and subdividing or
- 20 resubdividing real property;
- 21 (3) fees, insurance costs, or recording costs
- 22 associated with the development of the subdivision;
- 23 (4) costs of providing proper infrastructure
- 24 necessary to support residential uses;
- 25 (5) real estate commissions and marketing fees; and
- 26 (6) any other costs as the department by rule
- 27 determines to be reasonable and prudent to advance the purposes of

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- 1 this subchapter.
- 2 (c) A loan made by the department under the model
- 3 subdivision program may not bear interest and may not exceed a term
- 4 of 36 months.
- 5 (d) The department may offer a borrower under the model
- 6 subdivision program one loan renewal for each subdivision.
- 7 SECTION 6. Section 2306.786, Government Code, as added by
- 8 Chapter 1367, Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001,
- 9 is amended to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 2306.786. ADMINISTRATION OF MODEL SUBDIVISION
- 11 PROGRAM; RULES. (a) In administering the model subdivision
- 12 program, the department by rule shall adopt:
- 13 (1) any subdivision standards in excess of local
- 14 standards the department considers necessary;
- 15 (2) loan application procedures;
- 16 (3) program guidelines; and
- 17 (4) contract award procedures.
- 18 (b) The department shall adopt rules to:
- 19 (1) ensure that a borrower under the model subdivision
- 20 program sells real property under the program only to an individual
- 21 borrower, nonprofit housing developer, or for-profit housing
- 22 developer for the purposes of constructing residential dwelling
- 23 units; and
- 24 (2) require a borrower under the model subdivision
- 25 program to convey real property under the program at a cost that is
- 26 affordable to:
- 27 (A) individuals and families of extremely low

- 1 income; or
- 2 (B) individuals and families of very low income.
- 3 SECTION 7. Subchapter GG, Chapter 2306, Government Code, as
- 4 added by Chapter 1367, Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular
- 5 Session, 2001, is amended by adding Section 2306.787 to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 2306.787. COLONIA DOWN PAYMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.
- 8 (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Colonia" means a geographic area that:
- 10 (A) is an economically distressed area as defined
- by Section 17.921, Water Code; and
- 12 (B) is located in a county any part of which is
- 13 within 50 miles of an international border.
- 14 (2) "Eligible individuals and families" means
- individuals and families of extremely low and very low income who
- 16 reside in a colonia.
- 17 (b) The department shall establish the colonia down payment
- 18 assistance program to provide down payment assistance to
- 19 individuals and families of extremely low and very low income who
- 20 would otherwise remain in substandard colonias.
- 21 (c) On application, the department may provide a loan to
- 22 eligible individuals and families under this section by using money
- 23 from the portion of community development block grants that is set
- 24 aside under federal law to provide financial assistance to
- 25 <u>colonias. In a state fiscal year, the department may not provide</u>
- loans under this section using more than \$2 million from the
- 27 set-aside for colonias.

- 1 (d) A loan made by the department under the down payment
- 2 assistance program may bear interest at a reasonable rate set by the
- 3 <u>department and may not exceed a term of 30 years.</u>
- 4 (e) In administering the down payment assistance program,
- 5 the department by rule shall adopt program guidelines and loan
- 6 application procedures.
- 7 SECTION 8. Section 2306.586(b), Government Code, is amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (b) A self-help center shall set a goal to improve the
- 10 living conditions of residents in the colonias designated under
- 11 Section <u>2306.583(b)</u> [2306.583(a)(2)] within a <u>one-year</u> [two-year]
- 12 period after a contract is awarded under this subchapter.
- SECTION 9. Section 15.951(2), Water Code, as added by
- 14 Chapter 1234, Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001,
- is amended to read as follows:
- 16 (2) "Colonia" means a geographic area that:
- 17 (A) has a majority population composed of
- individuals and families of low income and very low income, based on
- 19 the federal Office of Management and Budget poverty index, and
- 20 meets the qualifications of [is] an economically distressed area
- 21 <u>under [as defined by]</u> Section 17.921; <u>or [and]</u>
- 22 (B) has the physical and economic
- 23 <u>characteristics of a colonia, as determined by the department</u> [is
- 24 located in a county any part of which is within 50 miles of an
- 25 <u>international border</u>].
- SECTION 10. Section 2306.255(g), Government Code, is
- 27 repealed.

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- 1 SECTION 11. (a) The Texas Department of Housing and
- 2 Community Affairs shall adopt the rules required by Section
- 3 2306.787, Government Code, as added by this Act, not later than
- 4 December 1, 2003.
- 5 (b) The changes in law made by Sections 8 and 9 of this Act
- 6 apply only to an application for assistance that is filed or a
- 7 contract that is awarded on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 12. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
