- 2 SECTION 3. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
- 3 over another Act of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003,
- 4 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
- 5 codes.
- 6 SECTION 4. The board of trustees of the Teacher Retirement
- 7 System of Texas shall adopt any rules required by the change in law
- 8 made by this Act not later than December 1, 2003.
- 9 SECTION 5. This Act applies only to a policy, contract, or
- 10 evidence of coverage that is delivered, issued for delivery, or
- 11 renewed on or after January 1, 2004. A policy, contract, or
