1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the creation of a coaching education program by the San  
1-10 Antonio Life Sciences Institute.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 75, Education Code, is  
1-13 amended by adding Section 75.205 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 75.205. COACHING EDUCATION PROGRAM. (a) The  
1-15 institute shall establish a coaching education program to be  
1-16 administered by The University of Texas Sport Sciences Institute.

1-17 (b) A program established under this section must address:

1-18 (1) the development of coaching philosophies  
1-19 consistent with local school district and school board goals;

1-20 (2) sport psychology that emphasizes coaching  
1-21 techniques, including communication, that motivate and reinforce  
1-22 the efforts of athletes;

1-23 (3) sport pedagogy that studies how athletes learn  
1-24 athletic skills and how to best teach athletes skills for sports;

1-25 (4) sport physiology, including principles of  
1-26 training, fitness for sport, nutrition for athletes, and  
1-27 development of training programs;

1-28 (5) sport management, including team management, risk  
1-29 management, and working within the context of an overall school  
1-30 program;

1-31 (6) training in other relevant subjects and skills,  
1-32 including cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and first aid  
1-33 instruction and certification;

1-34 (7) knowledge of and adherence to applicable federal,  
1-35 state, and local rules, including rules concerning gender equity  
1-36 and discrimination;

1-37 (8) knowledge of the essentials of character  
1-38 development and character education; and

1-39 (9) the development of the student athlete as a  
1-40 positive peer role model.

1-41 SECTION 2. The San Antonio Life Sciences Institute shall  
1-42 establish the coaching education program required by Section  
1-43 75.205, Education Code, as added by this Act, not later than January  
1-44 1, 2004.

1-45 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
