- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 5.275, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 Sec. 5.275. APPEAL. (a) The counsel may appeal a
- 7 substantial amendment by the commission to a proposal for decision
- 8 from the State Office of Administrative Hearings.
- 9 (b) The counsel may, under Section 2001.038, Government
- 10 Code, contest the validity of a package of rules adopted by the
- 11 commission on the basis that the rules were adopted without proper
- 12 legal procedure or that the rules exceed the commission's authority
- 13 [A ruling, decision, or other act of the commission may not be
- 14 appealed by the counsel].
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and
- 16 applies to rules finally adopted on or after that date. Rules
- 17 finally adopted before that date are governed by the law in effect
- 18 on the date the rules were finally adopted, and that law is
- 19 continued in effect for that purpose.
