## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 104, Family Code, is amended by adding 6 Section 104.007 to read as follows:
- Sec. 104.007. PRERECORDED VIDEOTAPED TESTIMONY OF CERTAIN

  PROFESSIONALS. (a) In this section, "professional" has the

  meaning assigned by Section 261.101(b).
- 10 (b) In a proceeding brought by the Department of Protective

  11 and Regulatory Services concerning a child who is alleged in a suit

  12 to have been abused or neglected, the court may order that the

  13 testimony of a professional be taken outside the courtroom and

  14 recorded on videotape.
- (c) In ordering testimony to be taken as provided by

  Subsection (b), the court shall ensure that the method of

  videotaping the testimony allows:
- 18 <u>(1) the parties and attorneys involved in the</u>
  19 <u>proceeding to be able to see and hear the professional as the</u>
  20 professional testifies; and
- 21 (2) the professional to be able to see and hear the 22 parties and attorneys examining the professional while the 23 professional is testifying.
- 24 (d) If the court permits the testimony of a professional

- 1 that is videotaped as provided by this section to be admitted during
- 2 the proceeding, the professional may not be compelled to be
- 3 physically present in court during the same proceeding to provide
- 4 the same testimony.
- 5 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 6 (b) The change in law made by this Act applies to testimony
- 7 taken on or after the effective date of this Act in a proceeding in a
- 8 suit affecting the parent-child relationship involving an
- 9 allegation of the abuse or neglect of a child regardless of whether:
- 10 (1) the allegation was made before, on, or after the
- 11 effective date of this Act; or
- 12 (2) the suit commenced before, on, or after the
- 13 effective date of this Act.
