1-12 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-13 AN ACT

1-14 relating to designation of defense economic readjustment zones and
1-15 defense readjustment projects.

1-16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-17 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 2310.110, Government
1-18 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-19 (b) The amended boundary:

1-20 (1) must be continuous;

1-21 (2) may not exceed the original size requirement of
1-22 Section 2310.101; and

1-23 (3) may not exclude any qualified business designated
1-24 as a defense readjustment project [~~area originally~~] included within
1-25 the boundary of the zone as designated.

1-26 SECTION 2. Section 2310.306, Government Code, is amended by
1-27 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

1-28 (d) The department may designate the same qualified
1-29 business in a readjustment zone as more than one defense
1-30 readjustment project.

1-31 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-32 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-33 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-34 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-35 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
