4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections 441.101(2), (3), and (4), Government
6	Code, are amended to read as follows:
7	(2) "Depository library" means the Texas State
8	Library, the Legislative Reference Library, the Library of
9	Congress, the Center for Research Libraries, or any other library
10	that the commission designates as a <u>site for retaining and allowing</u>
11	<pre>public access to state publications [depository library].</pre>
12	(3) "State agency" means <u>an executive, legislative, or</u>
13	judicial [ <del>a</del> ] state office, officer, department, division, bureau,
14	board, commission, [ <del>legislative</del> ] committee, authority,
15	institution, substate planning bureau, university system,
16	institution of higher education as defined by Section 61.003,
17	Education Code, or a subdivision of one of those entities.
18	(4) "State publication":
19	(A) means information in any format, <u>including</u>
20	materials in print or in an electronic format, that:
21	(i) is produced by the authority of or at
22	the total or partial expense of a state agency or is required to be
23	distributed under law by the agency; and
24	(ii) is publicly distributed outside the

1 agency by or for the agency; and 2 (B) does include information not the distribution of which is limited to: 3 4 (i) contractors with or grantees of the 5 agency; 6 (ii) persons within the agency or within 7 other government agencies; or 8 (iii) members of the public under a request 9 made under the open records law, Chapter 552. SECTION 2. Section 441.102(c), Government Code, is amended 10 to read as follows: 11 The commission shall establish and maintain a system, 12 (c) named the "Texas Records and Information Locator," or "TRAIL," to 13 allow electronic access, including access through the Internet, at 14 15 the Texas State Library and other depository libraries to state publications in an electronic format that have been made available 16 17 to the public by or on behalf of a state agency. SECTION 3. Section 441.103, Government Code, is amended by 18 amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsections (f), (g), 19 20 and (h) to read as follows: 21 (a) A state agency shall designate one or more staff persons as agency publications liaisons [contact persons] and shall notify 22 the Texas State Library of those persons' identities. 23 А 24 publications liaison [contact person] shall maintain a record of 25 the agency's state publications and shall furnish to the Texas State Library a list of the agency's new state publications as they 26 27 become available.

1 (b) A state agency shall furnish <u>copies of</u> its <u>printed</u> state 2 publications to the Texas State Library in the number specified by 3 commission rules. On the printing of or awarding of a contract for 4 the printing of a publication, a state agency shall arrange for the 5 required number of copies to be deposited with the Texas State 6 Library. The commission may not require more than 75 copies of a 7 printed state publication.

8 (f) A state agency shall make its printed state publications 9 accessible from the state agency's website in an electronic format. 10 If the state agency does not have a website, the agency shall 11 deposit the electronic source file for each printed state 12 publication in the manner prescribed by commission rules.

13 (g) A state agency shall include, for any state publication 14 in electronic format, regardless of its availability through the 15 Internet, identifying and descriptive information about the state 16 publication as specified by commission and Department of 17 Information Resources rules.

18 (h) If an electronic state publication is not printed or 19 available from the state agency's website, the state agency shall 20 furnish the Texas State Library copies in a manner prescribed by 21 commission rules. The commission may not require more than 75 22 copies of the publication.

8 (4) periodically issue a list of all state 9 publications that it has received <u>in print or storage media</u> to all 10 depository libraries and other libraries on request;

(5) catalog, classify, and index all state publications that it receives and distribute the cataloging, classification, and indexing information to depository libraries and to other libraries on request;

16 represented in regional and national automated library networks;

17 (7) index all state publications that are available <u>on</u>
 18 <u>the Internet</u> [in an electronic format] and make the index available
 19 <u>on the Internet</u> [in an electronic format]; <u>and</u>

20 (8) [provide on-line access to state publications that
21 can be accessed on-line; and

[<del>(9)</del>] provide other depository libraries appropriate access, at no charge, to state publications available in an electronic format.

If a state agency's printing is done by contract, an account for the printing may not be approved and a warrant may not be issued unless the agency first furnishes to the <u>Texas Building and Procurement</u> [<u>State Purchasing and General Services</u>] Commission a receipt from the state librarian for the publication or a written waiver from the state librarian exempting the publication from this subchapter. SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
