2	relating to the reporting duties of the attorney general.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 402.003, Government Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:
6	Sec. 402.003. REPORT. The attorney general shall report to
7	the governor on the first Monday of December of each even-numbered
8	year. The report must include the following information for the
9	preceding two years:
10	(1) [a statement of the number of indictments found by
11	grand juries in the state and the offenses charged;
12	[(2) a statement of the number of trials, convictions,
13	and acquittals for each offense;
14	[(3) a statement of the number of dismissals;
15	[(4) a summary of the judgments rendered or
16	conviction, the nature and amount of penalties imposed, and the
17	amount of fines collected;
18	$[\frac{(5)}{(5)}]$ a summary of the cases in which the state was a
19	party that were acted on by the supreme court and court of criminal
20	appeals; and
21	(2) [(6)] a summary of civil cases in which the state
22	was a party that were prosecuted or defended by the attorney general
23	in other state or federal courts.
24	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
