1-10 relating to the reporting duties of the attorney general.
1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-12 SECTION 1. Section 402.003, Government Code, is amended to
1-13 read as follows:
1-14 Sec. 402.003. REPORT. The attorney general shall report to
1-15 the governor on the first Monday of December of each even-numbered
1-16 year. The report must include the following information for the
1-17 preceding two years:
1-18 (1) ~~[a statement of the number of indictments found by~~
1-19 ~~grand juries in the state and the offenses charged;~~
1-20 ~~[(2) a statement of the number of trials, convictions,~~
1-21 ~~and acquittals for each offense;~~
1-22 ~~[(3) a statement of the number of dismissals;~~
1-23 ~~[(4) a summary of the judgments rendered on~~
1-24 ~~conviction, the nature and amount of penalties imposed, and the~~
1-25 ~~amount of fines collected;~~
1-26 ~~[(5)] a summary of the cases in which the state was a~~
1-27 party that were acted on by the supreme court and court of criminal
1-28 appeals; and
1-29 (2) ~~[(6)]~~ a summary of civil cases in which the state
1-30 was a party that were prosecuted or defended by the attorney general
1-31 in other state or federal courts.
1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
