- 2 relating to the Early High School Graduation Scholarship Program.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 56.204, Education Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (a) An eligible person under the Early High School
- 7 Graduation Scholarship program is entitled to $\frac{$2,000}{}$ [\$1,000] in
- 8 state tuition credits at a Texas public or private institution of
- 9 higher education.
- 10 (b) The use of a credit at a Texas private institution is
- 11 contingent on a private institution's agreement to match the state
- 12 tuition credit.
- 13 (c) A person eligible for a tuition credit under the tuition
- 14 credit program authorized by Rider 1223, page III-9, Chapter 19,
- 15 Acts of the 72nd Legislature, 1st Called Session, 1991 (the General
- 16 Appropriations Act), who did not receive a credit under that
- 17 program is eligible for and entitled to $\frac{$2,000}{$}$ [\$1,000] in state
- 18 tuition credits under this subchapter. This subsection expires
- 19 September 1, 2005.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
