- (2) fees for transfer as provided by Chapter 110; 11
- 12 (3) fees for the issuance and delivery of orders and
- 13 writs of income withholding in the amounts provided by Chapter 110;
- (4) a fee of [\$45] \$65 for each item of process to each 14
- individual on whom service is required, including service by 15
- certified or registered mail, to be paid to a sheriff, constable, or 16
- clerk whenever service of process is required; and 17
- (5) the fee for filing an administrative writ of 18
- withholding under Section 158.503(d). 19
