BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 1551, Insurance Code, as
ffective June 1, 2003, is amended by adding Section 1551.218 to
ead as follows:
Sec. 1551.218. HEALTH REIMBURSEMENT ARRANGEMENTS.
a) The board of trustees shall offer coverage through health
eimbursement arrangements. The board of trustees shall develop,
mplement, and administer health reimbursement arrangements.
(b) Health reimbursement arrangements offered under this
ection may only reimburse expenses for medical care, as defined by
ection 213(d), Internal Revenue Code of 1986.
(c) The board of trustees by rule shall establish the
aximum dollar amount for a coverage period that may be reimbursed
nder a health reimbursement arrangement. Any unused portion of
he maximum dollar amount at the end of a coverage period shall be
arried forward to increase the maximum reimbursement amount in
ubsequent coverage periods.
(d) The board of trustees may enter into a contract or
greement with an independent and qualified agency, individual, or
ntity to:
(1) develop, implement, or administer health

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reimbursement arrangements; or

(2) assist in those activities.

3 SECTION 2. Subchapter G, Chapter 1551, Insurance Code, as 4 effective June 1, 2003, is amended by adding Section 1551.321 to 5 read as follows:

6 <u>Sec. 1551.321. FUNDING OF HEALTH REIMBURSEMENT</u> 7 <u>ARRANGEMENTS. Health reimbursement arrangements offered under</u> 8 <u>Section 1551.218 shall be paid for solely by the employer. Employer</u> 9 <u>contributions to health reimbursement arrangements may not be</u> 10 <u>attributable to salary reductions or otherwise provided under the</u> 11 <u>cafeteria plan.</u>

12 SECTION 3. The board of trustees of the Employees 13 Retirement System of Texas is not required to offer health 14 reimbursement arrangements, as required by Section 1551.218, 15 Insurance Code, as added by this Act, before September 1, 2004.

16 SECTION 4. The board of trustees of the Employees 17 Retirement System of Texas shall adopt rules as required under 18 Section 1551.218, Insurance Code, as added by this Act, not later 19 than June 1, 2004.

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SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
