1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 302.021, Labor Code, is
1-14 amended to read as follows:

1-15 (a) The following job-training, employment, and
1-16 employment-related educational programs and functions are
1-17 consolidated under the authority of the division:

1-18 (1) adult education programs under Subchapter H,
1-19 Chapter 29, Education Code;

1-20 (2) proprietary school programs under Chapter 132,
1-21 Education Code;

1-22 (3) apprenticeship programs under Chapter 133,
1-23 Education Code;

1-24 (4) postsecondary vocational and technical
1-25 job-training programs that are not a part of approved courses or
1-26 programs that lead to licensing, certification, or an associate
1-27 degree under Chapters 61, 130, and 135, Education Code, Subchapter
1-28 E, Chapter 88, Education Code, and Subchapter E, Chapter 96,
1-29 Education Code;

1-30 (5) employment programs under Chapter 31, Human
1-31 Resources Code;

1-32 (6) the senior citizens employment program under
1-33 Chapter 101, Human Resources Code;

1-34 (7) the work and family policies program under Chapter
1-35 81;

1-36 (8) job-training programs funded under the Job
1-37 Training Partnership Act (29 U.S.C. Section 1501 et seq.) and under
1-38 the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 (29 U.S.C. Section 2801 et

SECTION 2. Subsection (b), Section 2308.102, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(b) The council shall assume the responsibilities assigned to the state advisory council under the following federal laws:

(1) the Job Training Partnership Act (29 U.S.C. Section 1501 et seq.);

(2) the Carl D. Perkins Vocational and Applied Technology Education Act (20 U.S.C. Section 2301 et seq.);

(3) ~~the National and Community Service Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. Section 12501 et seq.);~~

~~[(4)]~~ the Adult Education Act (20 U.S.C. Section 1201 et seq.);

(4) ~~[(5)]~~ the Wagner-Peyser Act (29 U.S.C. Section 49 et seq.);

(5) ~~[(6)]~~ Part F, Subchapter IV, Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. Section 681 et seq.);

(6) ~~[(7)]~~ the employment program established under Section 6(d)(4), Food Stamp Act of 1977 (7 U.S.C. Section 2015(d)(4)); and

(7) ~~[(8)]~~ the National Literacy Act of 1991 (20 U.S.C. Section 1201 et seq.).

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
