5	SECTION 1. The heading to Section 411.016, Government Code,

7	Sec. 411.016. SUPPLEMENTAL PAY FOR OVERTIME HOURS WORKED OR
8	PROJECTS FUNDED BY FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.
9	SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
10	amended by adding Sections 411.0161 and 411.0162 to read as
11	follows:
12	Sec. 411.0161. SUPPLEMENTAL PAY FOR PROFICIENCY IN SECOND
13	LANGUAGE. (a) The department may pay a supplement not to exceed
14	\$100 a month to an officer commissioned by the department who is
15	proficient in both English and a second language if:
16	(1) the department determines that the second language
17	is beneficial to protecting the public safety; and
18	(2) the commissioned officer is able to demonstrate
19	proficiency in the second language by reading, writing, and
20	demonstrating conversation skills in the second language as
21	determined by the department.
22	(b) Supplemental pay under this section is in addition to an
23	officer's regular salary.
24	Sec. 411.0162. SUPPLEMENTAL PAY FOR HIGHER EDUCATION.

1	(a) If an officer commissioned by the department has obtained one
2	of the following degrees, or a number of credit hours equivalent to
3	one of the following degrees, from an accredited public or private
4	college or university, the department may pay the officer
5	supplemental pay in an amount not to exceed:
6	(1) \$100 per month for an associate degree;
7	(2) \$200 per month for a bachelor's degree; or
8	(3) \$300 per month for a master's or more advanced
9	degree.
10	(b) The maximum amount of supplemental pay for higher
11	education that the department may pay to an officer who has obtained
12	more than one of the degrees listed in Subsection (a) is the maximum
13	amount of supplemental pay available under that subsection for the

15 SECTION 3. (a) The Department of Public Safety of the 16 State of Texas may implement Section 411.0161, Government Code, as 17 added by this Act, only during a fiscal period for which the 18 legislature specifically appropriates money to the Department of 19 Public Safety of the State of Texas for the purpose of funding 20 supplemental pay for proficiency in a second language under that 21 section.

(b) The Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas may implement Section 411.0162, Government Code, as added by this Act, only during a fiscal period for which the legislature specifically appropriates money to the Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas for the purpose of funding supplemental pay for higher education under that section.
