A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to customers of the state power program.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 35.101(2), Utilities Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (2) "Public retail customer" means a retail customer
- 7 that is an agency of this state, a state institution of higher
- 8 education, a public school district, a person who holds an oil and
- 9 gas lease granted under Chapter 52, Natural Resources Code, or a
- 10 political subdivision of this state.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 35.102, Utilities Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 35.102. STATE AUTHORITY TO SELL OR CONVEY POWER. The
- 14 commissioner, acting on behalf of the state, may sell or otherwise
- 15 convey power generated from royalties taken in kind as provided by
- 16 Sections 52.133(f), 53.026, and 53.077, Natural Resources Code,
- 17 directly to a public retail customer regardless of whether the
- 18 public retail customer is also classified as a wholesale customer
- 19 under other provisions of this title. To ensure that the state
- 20 receives the maximum benefit from the sale of power generated from
- 21 royalties taken in kind, the commissioner shall use all feasible
- 22 means to sell that power first to public retail customers that are
- 23 agencies of this state, institutions of higher education, or public
- 24 school districts. The remainder of the power, if any, may be sold

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- to <u>other</u> public retail customers [that are political subdivisions

 of this state].
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
